# Property Description

Bulkeley Great House represents one of the most unique properties in Barbados. The traditional covered patio, which surrounds the main house, has been recently extended on the eastern side to overlook a large free-form swimming pool. This pool has been constructed to give the appearance of a natural pond, with gently cascading waterfalls and a "sand-finished" bottom that extends beyond the water-level to form a shore.

The surrounding landscaping and complete impact of this pool is one of the most exceptional features of any property on the island. Another notable feature is the renovated outbuildings which now provide offices of an international standard. These offices create a mews-effect next to the main plantation house.

Bulkeley offers a total of 17,500 sq. ft. of total covered area, with the main house spread over three levels of 10,170 sq. ft. of covered space. The charming property features five bedrooms and four bathrooms, two reception areas, ample dining and entertainment areas and a guest cottage. In addition to the first and second floors, there is also a cellar space which provides a separate laundry area and room for storage.

Bulkeley Great House represents an Altman Signature Property, which qualifies it as a unique property of special interest.
